Notice to Borrowers

This notice is given to comply with any duty Lender may have to provide notice under <u>Section 1</u>, subsection (9) of HB4204. This Notice is without prejudice to Lender's right to contend that the provisions of HB4204 do not limit the exercise of some or all of such rights and remedies.
